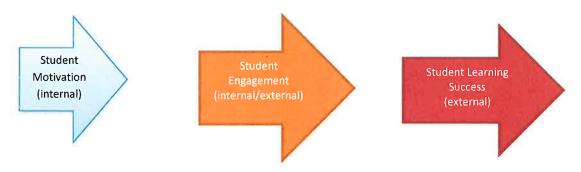

# Summary Statements – RETURN TO LEARN

- Participation:
- Stayed the same between MOY & EOY, slightly below the Stride metric
- Enrollment was higher in winter and spring and more students with documented barriers
- Growth: Slight increase in growth metric between testing windows
- Subgroups: 2 to 3 subgroups had higher growth in both content areas than students without additional supports



#### **State Testing**

- Scores still embargoed although we have reviewed MSTEP and are using it to plan for next year's science and social studies classes.
- All students are required to test
  - MIACCESS is assessment given to students who have more severe cognitive impairments and are Certificate of Completion through functional curriculum.

#### STATE TESTING - MI ACCESS

• Teacher from that program administered that state required test to her students traveling around the state with another special education teacher. They made the most of the trip – loving to interact face to face with her students.

#### Stride Update

Some recent changes in the Pupil Auditing Manuel are the day, hour, and attendance requirements have returned to the pre-pandemic 180 days and 1,098 hours. The flexibility to base these requirements solely on course content that was available during 2020-21 has been removed. A new subsection was added to give auditors additional information about the end of year audit requirement for participation at a Cyber School. Cyber School end of year audit requirement cyber schools are required to track pupils' participation through attendance in the offered education programs for the



duration of a student's enrollment. Will keep monitor any other changes. Agenda coming for the Stride Retreat.
